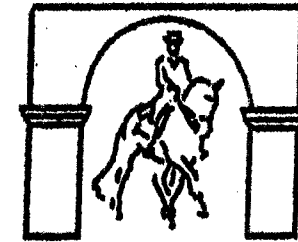


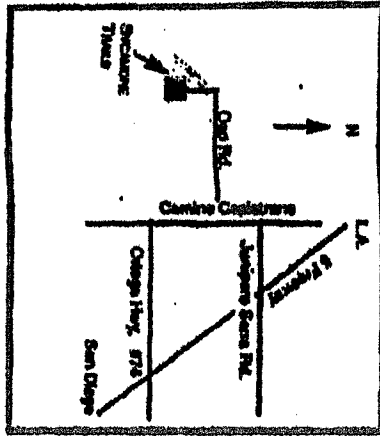

RULES : READ CAREFULLY!

This show is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF rule book and will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

Management will not be liable or responsible for any loss, accident or damage that may occur during the duration of the show by any exhibitor or horse or traffic infraction..

Entries MUST include photocopies of all membership for horse, rider , owner and trainer, entered in rated competitions for the following organizations: USEF USDF CDS. Horses are required to have BOTH USEF and USDF lifetime or HID in order to be entered in rated competition. Membership can be made online to all organizations, refer to the membership forms in premium. The back of the entry must be signed in all spaces. Entries missing fees, signatures, copies of cards or any other info will be accessed a fee of \$35.00 the day of the show.

Refunds are only issued prior to the closing date. After the closing date there are NO REFUNDS FOR ANY REASON. Returned checks will be accessed a \$25.00 fee

All entries must be postmarked on or before closing date. Late entries will be charged a \$25.00 fee

If schedule becomes full on or before entry close, entries may be on waiting list. Entries on wait list will be notified of such event and entries returned if no availability in schedule.

Times will be called the week prior to competition. Reasonable consideration will be given to scheduling.

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all regular competitions, eventing competitions at the preliminary level or above and combined driving competitions at the advanced level, dressage, reining, and vaulting competitions and endurance rides provided the respective breed/ discipline category fee has been paid. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at regular competitions, eventing competitions, dressage competitions, reining competitions and combined driving competitions upon payment of a \$30. nonmember registration fee Participants in the following classes are exempted from the requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes(academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux, and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA endorsed reining competitions; 8) opportunity classes; 9) citizens of other nations who have proof in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation; 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in dressage sport horse breeding classe

In the case of inclement weather it is the responsibility of the exhibitor to ascertain if the show has been canceled due to footing and arena closures. Canceled show fees will be refunded less a \$25. office fee.

Ribbons will be awarded through fifth place. Prizes will be awarded in class/divisions with more than 3 riders.

Stabling: A limited number of stalls may be available, please call manager for availability

Lunging in designated area only, not in warmup arena , dogs must be kept on leash at all times

Minors who do not have a valid drivers license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid drivers license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s) guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s) guardian(s) or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with rule 6. Wheelchairs and other motility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

Federation Entry Agreement Effective 12/1/09

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaulteur or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of the Competition. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the Competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cablecasts, **broadcasts, internet, film, new media** or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the Competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the Competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.

Federation Release, Assumption of Risk, Waiver, and Indemnification

This document waives important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing.

I AGREE in consideration for my participation in this Competition CDS-SJC and Capistrano Dressage to the following:

I AGREE that "the Federation" and "Competition" as used herein includes the Licensee and Competition Management, as well as all of their officials, officers, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers and Federation affiliates.

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in the Competition with my horse, as a rider, driver, handler, vaulteur, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, or as parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and the Competition involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death. ("Harm").

I AGREE to **hold harmless and** release the Federation and the Competition from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any Harm of any nature caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm **arises or results** resulted, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of the Federation or the Competition.

I AGREE to expressly assume all risks of Harm to me or my horse, including Harm resulting from the negligence of the Federation or the Competition.

I AGREE to indemnify (that is, to pay any losses, damages, or costs incurred by) the Federation and the Competition and to hold them harmless with respect to claims for Harm to me or my horse, and for claims made by others for any Harm caused by me or my horse **while** at the Competition. I have read the Federation Rules about protective equipment, including GR801 and **if applicable**, EV114, and I understand that I am entitled to wear protective equipment without penalty, and I acknowledge that the Federation strongly encourages me to do so while WARNING that no protective equipment can guard against all injuries. If I am a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child's participation and AGREE to all of the above provisions and AGREE to assume all of the obligations of this Release on the child's behalf. I represent that I have the requisite training, coaching and abilities to safely compete in this competition.

I AGREE that if I am injured at this competition, the medical personnel treating my injuries may provide information on my injury and treatment to the Federation on the official USEF accident/injury report form.

BY SIGNING BELOW, I AGREE to be bound by all applicable Federation Rules and all terms and provisions of this entry blank.
